<p>1. Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906</p> <p>SC 1903</p> <p>Title 22 Sec. 4.41</p>	<p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of remedial and enrichment instruction for resident students of this district.</p>
<p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall employ teaching and administrative staff; provide necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment; and utilize schools or other facilities as required.</p> <p>Planned instruction offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.</p> <p>Students eligible for the district's summer school program shall include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Resident students who are eligible for regular attendance in district schools. 2. Students eligible by standards established by the governmental funding source. <p>Tuition fees established by the Board shall be charged to resident students and nonresident students.</p> <p>With regard to transportation, the Board does not accept responsibility for any student.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for developing regulations for:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Planning the summer school curriculum. 2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments. 3. Assigning students and staff. 4. Evaluating and reporting on student progress.

Developing and enforcing rules for student behavior.</p> <p>Guidelines for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.</p>
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
