Authority</p> <p>PA SC 1326</p> <p>PA Code Title 22 Sec. 12.1</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">234.1 MARRIED STUDENTS</p> <p>No married student who is eligible to attend district schools shall be denied an educational program.</p> <p>The District is committed and dedicated to the task of providing the best education possible for every child for as long as s/he can profit from attendance and his/her conduct is compatible with the welfare of the group. The Board sets forth the following regulations and guiding principles pertaining to married students and other related problems:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Students who are married must declare their married status at the time of marriage or at the time of enrollment in the school.b. Married students shall be expected to conduct themselves in a commendable manner and refrain from undue references to married life. Any problems arising in this respect shall be handled on an individual basis by the counselors. The decisions in each case shall be of such a nature as to insure a wholesome school atmosphere for all the students. <p>Students who are married and living with a spouse are considered to be emancipated and are considered to be eligible students in accordance with Policy No. 216 (Student Records).</p>
