CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEES</p> <p>Citizen advisory committees can be useful in keeping the Board and administration informed with regard to community opinion and in representing the community in the study of specific school issues.</p> <p>The Board shall have the authority to create and dissolve advisory committees.</p> <p>In creating an advisory committee, the Board shall define the committee assignment and shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Appoint residents who are interested and can make some special contribution to the committee's function. 2. Approve appointment of residents, staff members and/or students recommended by the Superintendent. 3. Seek the widest range of community interest and backgrounds. 4. Appoint a chairperson. <p>Specific topics for study or well-defined areas of activity shall be assigned to each committee immediately following its appointment. Each committee shall be instructed as to the length of time each member shall serve, the service the Board wishes it to render, the resources the Board intends to provide, and the approximate date on which the Board wishes to dissolve the committee. Upon completing its assignment, each committee shall be dissolved.</p> <p>Recommendations of advisory committees shall not reduce the responsibility of the Board, which shall be free to accept or reject the recommendations.</p> <p>Meetings of an advisory committee are not regular meetings of the Board and shall not be open to the public.</p>
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
