Part One of this affidavit is to be completed by the Randolph resident(s) with whom the student(s) will be or is residing.

Part Two of this affidavit is to be completed by the non-resident parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the student(s).

Part Three of this affidavit is to be completed by the landlord of the Randolph resident(s) with whom the student(s) will be residing, in the event that the resident leases property in Randolph without a formal written lease.
