Dear ECS Parents,

Our Heavenly Father has gifted us with the language of numbers. Math fluency is much like that of any language – practice is essential. This year the Math Department is going to use an online program called Delta Math for summer math work. We believe this will benefit our students in several different ways:

- Questions are categorized by types, and multiple attempts will be given per problem.
- When a student misses a problem, the website not only shows the solution but also explains the solution. This should make the second attempt much easier. Additionally, there are video examples for many of the problems.
- Our teachers will be able to see attempts/successes and will know before school begins where to focus beginning of the year review.
- Students and parents (using the student's login) can monitor progress on the site.
- Students cannot lose a packet.

Summer work will be posted on <u>www.deltamath.com</u> by **June 1**; however, we highly recommend that the students take a break from online learning, and begin work in July.

NEW TO DELTA MATH:

- 1) Go to <u>www.deltamath.com</u>.
- 2) Select "Create Account" in the upper right-hand corner.
- 3) Choose "Student".
- 4) The student will then be asked for a **Teacher Code: 724770**.
- 5) The student must select the last class that they completed at ECS by the pull-down tab labeled Class or Period. There also might be a "skills builder" for your class as well as summer work. Please select both before entering an email and password.
- 6) Please create an account. Please write down your password in a safe place.

IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A DELTA MATH ACCOUNT:

- 1) Log onto your account in <u>www.deltamath.com</u>.
- 2) Select "Tools" in the upper right-hand corner, choose "Manage Login and Teachers."
- 3) Below the heading "TEACHERS AND CLASS INFORMATION," select "Add Teacher."
- 4) The student will then be asked for a **Teacher Code: 724770**.
- 5) The student must select the last class that they completed at ECS by the pull-down tab labeled Class or Period.

IF YOU HAVE A DELTA MATH ACCOUNT AND ARE ALREADY IN THE ECS MATH CLASS:

- 1) Log onto your account in <u>www.deltamath.com</u>.
- 2) Select "Tools" in the upper right-hand corner, choose "Manage Login and Teachers."
- 3) Below the heading "TEACHERS AND CLASS INFORMATION," select "Add Teacher."
- 4) Select the **EDIT** button that is next to **ECS Math**.
- 5) The student must select the last class that they completed at ECS by the pull-down tab labeled Class or Period.

A couple of things to keep in mind:

- It is better for the student if they complete this work closer to the start of the new school year so that skills are fresh when they return to school. We recommend that they start in July.
- Work must be completed by the start of the school year.
- The work WILL take more than one sitting. Please help your student set realistic goals and a week by week plan to work through the required problems.
- Summer work will count as a quiz grade for the first quarter. Failure to do summer work will result in a "0"
