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Darien Summer School: Background

- Comprehensive, diversified, learner-centered program
- Available to all students (Darien and other communities) in grades Pre-K through 12th grade
- 220 choices:
 - Academic classes, to include high school credit courses as well as enrichment
 - Variety of athletic, art, music and theatre programs

Structure of Program

- 5 week program
- Runs June 26, 2017 through July 28, 2017
- 7:30-8:30am extended day option (canceled)
- 8:30-12:30pm (2 hour courses)
- 12:30-3:30pm, extended day offerings
- Weekly sports camps (varied times)



Structure of Program

Middlesex Jump Start:

- Takes place the first 2 weeks of DSS
- Available to all 5th grade students transitioning to MMS
- 5th grade students from all 5 elementary schools are invited Summer Pals Program (Tokeneke):
 - 5 week program
 - Available to children aged 3–5 designed to promote kindergarten readiness

Student Enrollment

- Total class registration 1,546 students
 - Class registration was 1,386 last year
- Many students are enrolled in multiple classes
 - New classes this year included. Tiny Chefs Cooking Mad Science, Blogging 101, Fun with STEM



Staffing

- 137 staff members:
 - Certified teachers, athletic coaches and DHS student assistants
