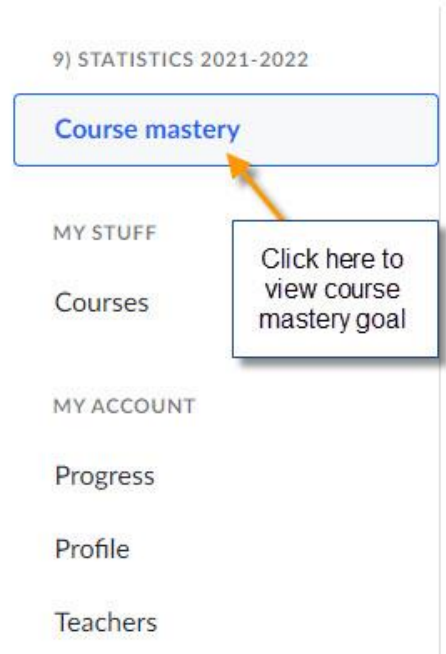


Math special notes:

If your child already has an account in Khan Academy, please make sure that they have their real name visible to teachers by following the directions on the summer assignment website. This will allow our math teachers to better assist them as they prepare for the school year.

Khan Academy now has a new course called *Get ready* which is designed to sharpen math skills used in the upcoming school year. This is a mastery-based course and we encourage your child to master as many skills as possible prior to the first day of class. In years past we created special assignments that required class codes, but the new Khan Academy *Get Ready* courses have taken their place. Once you join the class via the link on the website, please allow 24 hours (Monday-Friday) for Bishop Dunne Faculty to assign the course mastery content to your account.

Once the course has been assigned when you login to your course you will see something like this for your class:
