End of Year Technology Turn In

Hello Skyview Families:

All district-owned computers and hotspots that have been assigned to students during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school year must be returned to school by June 18, 2021. This includes the device, charging cord, and any cases that were provided for device protection.

If you would like to check out a device for summer use, the current device still needs to be returned. You can request a new device for summer use by using the [Device Request Form](#). This form must be completed prior to June 9th. These requests will be filled as they are received.

If a student does not return their assigned device and components by June 18th, a fine will be assessed to the family in the amount of the replacement cost of the device.

Cohort A: June 15th during 6th period or after school from 1:15-3:15

Cohort B: June 17th during 3rd period or after school from 1:15-3:15

Remote Only (Cohort C): June 16th, 9-3pm drop off times are designated by alpha (please see schedule below)

Throughout the process described below, students and families will remain in their cars to collect and return items. Please help keep our staff safe and wear masks when coming to campus.

Thanks to the generous help of PTSA and our SMS ASB, **EVERY 6th & 7th** grade student will have a “goody bag” with fun surprises, your student’s bag might also include classroom projects and/or a pre-ordered yearbook (if purchased). For some students, we’ve added end of year award/participation certificates.

DROP OFF/PICK-UP PROTOCOLS FOR FAMILIES

- Pick-up **must occur during the scheduled time for your student.** Scheduled to arrive by your **student's last name, alphabetically.**
- Our distribution station will be set up behind the gym, please use the **BUS LOOP** entrance
- You may only pick up items that belong to your child.
- If you are returning your District provided device please print and sign a Student Device Return [form](#). **You must return this form with your current device.** All components must be returned. This includes the device, charging cord, and any cases that were provided for device protection. (no summer devices will be handed out during this time)
- Items for students to return
 - Textbooks
 - Library books
 - Band instruments - 8th grade only, or if SMS loaned instrument needs repair
 - Classroom materials that teachers provided
 - Computers and other assigned technology
- Before you arrive on the drop off/pick up day
 - **Prepare a sign** with your child’s first and last name in LARGE print. Display this sign so that it is clearly visible at the front of your vehicle (attached to windshield visor or propped up on the dash).

- Have all items in the trunk of your car, easily available for removal.
- If you do not have a trunk, you must be ready to hand materials to staff through your passenger-side window.
- Drop off/pick up directions
 - All parents/students/passengers must stay in their cars at all times.
 - Please **arrive only during your assigned time**. This is essential to avoid cars backing into the street and blocking traffic. Canyon Creek Elementary will also be conducting distribution on June 16th - Avoid blocking access to their parking lot.
 - All car passengers **must wear a mask**, or use something to cover mouth and nose.
 - **Display your pre-made sign** with your student's first and last name in the front windshield.
 - Remain in a **single file** line along the curb. **Continue pulling forward** as you are able. There will be staff and/or signs directing you.
 - Drop off/ pick up will occur behind the gym, along the curb and fence.
 - **No parking is allowed.**
 - Once you arrive at the distribution point, a staff member will take materials you are dropping off and/or hand you your students "goody bag":
 - **All parents/students/passengers must stay in their cars at all times.**
- Once you are finished with the drop off/pick up you will continue all the way around the back of the building and exit through the main entrance (near Canyon Creek)

Students are to adhere to the 6ft social distancing guidelines and always wear a mask when on campus.



Did you miss the Yearbook presales? If so, you will have another opportunity to purchase a 20-21 yearbook on Tuesday(6/15) & Thursday(6/17) before school or during 6th/3rd period. Please bring check or cash in the exact amount of \$20 to purchase a yearbook in the main office before school or the breezeway during distribution.

If you are a remote student who did not pre-order a yearbook you may purchase one on Wednesday 6/16 in the main office with cash/check in the amount of \$20 or credit card.

Homework Deadlines

Deadlines have been set for students to turn in work. Friday, June 11th, is the last day students will have to turn in current assignments. Monday, June 14th, is the last date for students to turn in missing assignments. No late work will be accepted after June 14th.

Incoming 6th graders

Hello, incoming 6th grade families! We are looking forward to seeing you at Skyview for the 21/22 school year.

All incoming 6th graders are required to complete a new health registration form for Skyview Middle School, [found here](#). Please fill out both pages of the form, sign it, and return it to jcelms@nsd.org anytime between now and the end of August.

Current 6th graders

A reminder that all students entering 7th grade must have their Tdap booster in order to attend the first day of school on September 1st. [Tdap is required once a student turns 11 years old and is in 7th grade](#). Please ensure your student receives their Tdap prior to August 31st. Medication Pickup

Please see the below information if your student has medication in the Skyview Health Room. *All medications need to be picked up*, and cannot be stored in the health room over the summer.

If your student has emergent, life-saving medication in the health room (epi-pens, seizure medication, or glucagon), the medication cannot be picked up prior to their last day of school, listed below. Non-emergent medication can be picked up anytime between now and the end of the school year by an authorized adult. In addition to medications, I will be providing you with the proper paperwork you will need to have medications at school for the 21/22 school year.

[Cohort B \(Thursdays/Fridays\)- Medication pick up is Friday, June 18th, 12:30pm-1:30pm](#)

2021-22 NORTH CREEK HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS REGISTRATION

If you will be a freshman at NCHS next year and are interested in participating in sports, Athletics registration for all sports is OPEN for the 2021-22 school year. FinalForms is an online registration platform for Athletics registration. You must be registered to receive information and updates from coaches, including information on possible summer conditioning sessions.

Required Prior to Participation in Athletics

To be cleared to participate in the first day of weight training/conditioning, tryouts, or practice, a FinalForms registration must be completed by both parent and student and a current [sports physical](#) must be on file with the NCHS Athletic Office. Sports physicals are good for two years from the exam date and can be uploaded in FinalForms during the registration process.

Visit our [Register for Athletics](#) page for more information and to register on FinalForms. Because the default year is 20-21 until June 13, you will need to click on the Switch to 21/22 Registration [BLUE](#) button to register.

Academic Eligibility Requirements

Student athletes in high school are expected to meet or exceed a 2.0 GPA to be eligible to participate in school-sponsored activities. There are regular grade checks for each sports season.

- NSD Standard: Minimum 2.0 GPA each semester
- WIAA Standard: Passing 6 classes

SMS Attendance

Parents/guardians must notify the Attendance Office to excuse absences (within 72 hours per WA State Law.)

If your student will be attending classes **remotely on HA or HB “in person”** scheduled days, it is important for parents/guardians to inform the attendance office as soon as possible, preferably in the morning before school. All students must **“sign in”** on Wednesdays and asynchronous learning days to be marked present.

To report or verify absences contact:

* If your student is experiencing a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, cough or loss of smell or taste, report any of these 3 symptoms in your voicemail or email message.

Late Arrival “in person” day: If your student arrives late to school they must go to the Attendance Office or see school nurse to complete the *Health Check* process before going into a classroom - see [Late Arrivals](#)

Early Dismissal “in person” day: Please limit your student leaving school early only when truly necessary. Pre-arrange in advance and allow extra time to dismiss your child from class - see [Early Dismissals](#)

Review your student’s attendance records: in [ParentVUE](#) If your student was marked absent in error, contact their teacher to correct within 3-school days, otherwise, notify the attendance office before the end of the school year.
