Over the last 37 years, the Meadows has grown from a school housed in trailers on a donated car lot behind the Meadows Mall to the sprawling 40-acre campus we occupy today. The buildings and grounds we enjoy now are due to the generosity of founders, parents, alumni, alumni parents, and community partners.

While we have been fortunate not to have needed significant capital enhancements over the course of the last decade, in order for us to continue to be the preeminent independent school in the region and one of the best in the nation, the time has come for a new expansion. I am proud to present to you the plans for an expansion to the Sarah D. Barder Hall Upper School building. This project will allow us to:

- Provide vital support for our increasing Upper School enrollment with the addition of five classrooms, along with additional locker bays, and restroom facilities.
- Create a state-of-the-art workshop classroom as a home for our growing Middle and Upper School programs in robotics, engineering, and drone construction.
- Double the space our Lower School science classroom currently occupies, allowing K-5 students the opportunity to engage in more hands-on exploration of science, technology, and engineering.
- Allow opportunities for community members to enjoy a meeting space in the heart of campus with a new outdoor classroom for students and faculty.
- Move on-campus storage out of the current temporary administration buildings and provide a permanent home for facilities offices and custodial staff.

Throughout our history, every community member has had a role to play in the success of The Meadows. As such, we look forward to your support of this project that will positively support the educational experiences of hundreds of students on our campus each and every day.

Campus Map

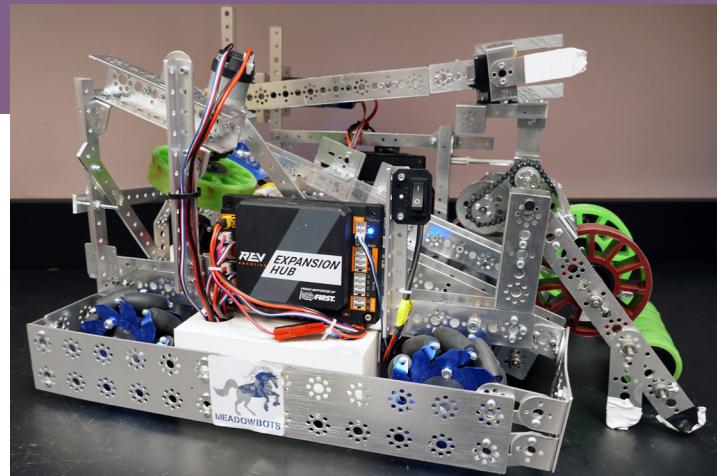

Capital campaigns exist to renovate or build new educational facilities, make improvements to the campus infrastructure, and strengthen the school's general and financial aid endowment.
