In an effort to be respectful to our students' and their families' needs, the Madison Metropolitan School District has adopted an agreement form for those families who do not wish to receive notices and/or letters about their child's disability related behavior which is eligible for an exemption from the expulsion process. We recognize there are situations where student behaviors are directly caused by the student's disability and thus are exempted from the standard disciplinary process.

The Madison Metropolitan School District's Behavior Education Plan describes our district's disciplinary policy and includes a variety of proactive supports, interventions, and the rights of staff, students, and parents.

This Agreement only waives the parent and/or legal guardian's right to receive any and all notices in relation to their child's behavior at school, when: 1) the school elects to request an exemption from the expulsion process, and 2) the Office of Progressive Discipline decides to exempt the child from the expulsion process.

By signing this Agreement, you are indicating that:

- □ I do not wish to receive expulsion exemption forms regarding my child during the 2020-2021 school year.
- □ I do not wish to receive notices from the Office of Progressive Discipline indicating my child is exempt from the expulsion process during the 2020-2021 school year.
- While I do not wish to receive notices of my child's behavior in relation to the exemption from the expulsion process, I understand that the Madison Metropolitan School District reserves will document and record my child's behavior incidents for the purposes of evaluating and improving educational programming and services.
