Northshore Virtual Program: Continuous Learning 2.0+



- Following guidance from OSPI for Continuous Learning 2.0+ (CL 2.0+)
- Daily Monday-Friday schedule
- 70% synchronously (live) and up to 30% asynchronously (independent).
- Daily attendance
- For students with health and safety concerns related to in-person learning
- State testing will be required unless a parent opts the student out
- Options for students to come on-site for learning or social activities
- Classes will be taught by Northshore teachers
- EAP (Elementary Advanced Placement) will be offered.
- Advanced Placement will be offered at the High School
- AAP (Academic Advanced Placement) will be offered at the Middle School
- Special Education and English Learner programs will be served according to state law

Similarities

Remote Learning 2020-21 and Northshore Virtual Program

- Learning Management System: Schoology
- Access to a district device, if needed
- Northshore educators
- Combination of synchronous (live) and asynchronous (independent) learning

Differences



Remote Learning 2020-21 and Northshore Virtual Program

- No Asynchronous Wednesdays- classes will be held 5 days a week
- Less asynchronous time for students
- Structured schedule
- No Hybrid option
- All students will be a part of the Northshore Virtual Program and not their home school
- Opportunities for Learning Hubs or other face to face activities

- This schedule would be 3 periods each day for Middle School, periods 1-3 one day and 4-6 the next
- High School will have a 4th Block to reflect the 7 periods of our Northshore High Schools
- School will start and end the same time daily (Wednesday will reflect the district early release time and include all class periods)
- The schedule will go approximately from 8am-1:45pm, except on Wed.
