5470 – FINAL EXAMINATION EXEMPTION: HIGH SCHOOL

I. Eligibility

- A. The policy is only applicable to seniors who qualify according to the definition and criteria.
- B. Senior students who qualify for the exemption may exercise their right not to take a final exam as per the criteria for eligibility for exemption listed below.
- C. Senior students who qualify for the exemption but wish to take the exam may exercise that right.

II. Definition: Final Exam

- A. The exemption applies only to full-year courses. Half-year semester courses are not included in the policy.

III. Criteria for Eligibility for Exemption

- A. Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, a senior may be exempt from taking the final in each and every full-year course in which he or she is enrolled provided that he or she has earned an average for the year that is greater than or equal to a 93.
