Dear Parents,

Each year we ask you to fill out various forms in order to comply with **Pennsylvania State Health Requirements**. Some of these forms require physical or dental examinations. I am writing to you now so that you may schedule these exams in time for your student to be on campus in the Fall 2021 Trimester.

Health Forms are assigned to each student in **Back to School Forms** on our website, solebury.org.

In short:

ALL students need a completed PA Department of Health Physical Examination form, including an updated immunization record

In addition, **all NEW students need:**

- A completed dental examination form
- A test for exposure to tuberculosis (PPD) if indicated

Physical examinations completed prior to May 1st cannot be used for the upcoming school year. We recognize that insurance companies limit the number of physical exam visits to one per year, so if your student's yearly exam date does not fall between May 1 and the start of school we ask that you have your physician complete the physical examination form based on the information gathered at your student's last visit.

Please note that students participating in any **Fall Interscholastic Sports** must return all medical forms before the start of preseason practices (Monday, August 30, 2021).

Thank you so much for assisting us in gathering this required information by submitting it as soon as you get it—we appreciate your efforts!
