#### ParentSquare



ParentSquare is your primary communication link with Avon Schools. Whenever there is timely and important news or updates, you can expect to hear it first through ParentSquare.

And, the best way to interact with ParentSquare is through the mobile app. It's available in the App Store and Google Play.

#### **Titan Family Portal**



Families may register with the Titan Family Portal to monitor lunch accounts and complete free and reduced applications. To create a new account, visit the Titan website.

For new accounts, make sure to have your student ID available when signing up for access and be aware that there is a service fee of \$2.60 per transaction. Once an account is established, meal and purchase history can be viewed and account controls can be set to send reminders of low balances and automatically add funds.

Step-by-step instructions for accessing the Titan Family Portal are available to help you get set up and running.

#### Nutrislice

View your child's school menus with Nutrislice.

# TRANSPORTATION



Parents may view bus stop information using ELink. This can be accessed throughout the school year to obtain the most up-to-date bus stop information.

Please login to ELink beginning July 19, 2021, and check it often, up to the first day of school. Bus stops may be altered slightly after July 19th due to new students enrolling daily. The first-day bus stop information will be available to parents for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year.

Students should be waiting at their assigned bus stop five (5) minutes prior to the scheduled pickup time.



The Avon Community School Corporation is excited to provide the My Stop App to parents!

My Stop is a free app, parents may use during the school year. Parents may download the app from the App Store or Google Play from any smartphone.

My Stop allows parents to track their students' bus location and scheduled arrival times.

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### How to Use Versatrans My Stop

Versatrans My Stop allows parents to track their students' bus location and arrival times as well as receive notifications on delays or other pertinent information. It is an application that can be downloaded on the Apple or Android Store on your smartphone.

#### Step 1: Downloading the Versatrans My Stop App

- Type "Versatrans My Stop" into the search field in the App Store (for Apple users) or Play Store (for Android Users)
- Select Versatrans My Stop and download
- After downloading My Stop navigate to the application and tap on it to open it.

#### Step 2: Logging In

Your username and password are the same as your Versatrans e-Link username and password.

#### Step 3: Navigating the Map Page

- After logging in you will arrive at the Map section. Here you will see your student's bus location and the estimated time of arrival.
- If you have multiple students riding buses on this screen there is an arrow with a dropdown menu to switch between your students.
- Remember if the bus is not on route you will not able to see its location.

In order to assist us and help you more efficiently, we ask you to register. Currently MLM is operating in a drive-through format.

1. Please follow the signs when you arrive at AISE property, they will direct you West to the back of AISE. This is where the line starts for the drive through.

2. You will be greeted by a MLM member and this is where you will check in. Your family size will be written on a piece of paper and places on your front window. You will then be directed to drive up to the volunteers.

3. The volunteers will place a box of packaged food according to family size in your trunk. Each family will receive – milk, eggs, frozen foods, and refrigerated foods when available.

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# **School Safety**

Avon Community Schools takes the safety of our students and staff seriously and continuously works to provide the safest and most secure learning environment.

We collaborate with city, county, state, and national safety officials on national best practices. Avon Community Schools has 12 certified Indiana School Safety Specialists that are trained to lead the development and implementation of school safety practices within our schools.

### **Emergency Drills**

Drills are an important aspect of school safety and will be used as teachable moments for our staff and students. Indiana Code requires each school to conduct monthly fire drills, one severe weather drill per semester, and one man-made occurrence (lockdown) drill per semester.

Avon Schools utilize the concepts of ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) when conducting lockdown drills. ALICE focuses on various courses of action that help staff and students respond most effectively to a crisis situation. This is an options-based training, highlighting situational awareness and decision making. No single response fits all crisis scenarios, however making sure staff and students know their options for response will help them to react effectively.

### **Visitor Information**

Avon Schools require all visitors to check-in at the front office using our visitor management system, Safe Visitor. This system requires visitors to scan their driver's license or state identification card for a check of their record. A temporary badge is provided to all visitors to wear while in our buildings. As our visitors leave school, they scan and return that badge to the front office staff.

Interested in volunteering at school or attending a field trip? All volunteers must have a criminal history background check done prior to volunteering at school. You can check with the building's front office staff to see if your background check is current. If you have multiple students who attend multiple schools in Avon, you only need one criminal background check.

# Winter Weather Delays & Closures

Indiana weather can be unpredictable. From time to time, it may cause us to call for a delay, early dismissal, e-learning day, or even a closure. Here are the factors we consider in the decision-making process and some helpful resources for caregivers and students alike.

### WHAT FACTORS DO WE CONSIDER WHEN MAKING THE CALL TO DELAY OR CANCEL SCHOOL?



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The **safety** of our students and staff is always our primary consideration. School is one of the safest places to be even when the weather is bad:

- State, Town, and Avon Schools staff do a great job clearing highways, streets, and school lots.
- Buses are safe, warm, and better-equipped to handle poor conditions than most cars.
- School buildings are warm, dry, well-lit and secure even in the worst weather.

Remaining open and on-time is often the best decision for families:

- · Caregivers don't have to decide who remains home.
- Children don't have to spend the day unattended.
- School cafeterias serve nutritious lunches.
- Temperature is often no better two hours later than it is early in the morning.
- Parents of student drivers can sign up to ride the bus by contacting Transportation at (317) 544-6140 at least 36 hours in advance.



The **timing** of delays and closures can be tricky because the weather changes fast and forecasts can be wrong.

- We rarely make the call to delay or cancel school at night. Most often, we do so in the morning. That gives
- our team the chance to make the most accurate
  assessment possible.



There is no formula for the amount of snow, ice, sleet, wind or low temperature necessary to cause a delay, early dismissal, or cancellation.

Whenever there's a forecast of winter weather, a team of district administrators hits the road before 4:30 a.m. to assess. They compare notes, watch developments, and consult with local authorities on road conditions. We strive to make a decision and communicate with parents by 6:00 a.m.





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We will notify you of delays, early dismissals, and cancellations via ParentSquare, social media, and avonschools.org. You can also watch for updates on local TV: CBS4, WRTV-6, WISH-TV8, and WTHR-13.
