

Diocesan Updates

Statement of The Bishops of The Province of Baltimore And The Archdiocese of Washington June 2, 2021

Lifting the General Dispensation from the Obligation to Attend Mass

We, the Catholic Bishops of the Province of Baltimore and the Archdiocese of Washington, give thanks to Almighty God for the progress our country has made in curbing the coronavirus pandemic. The average number of new cases of COVID-19 continues to decline due to the observance of safety protocols and the increase of the availability of the vaccine. At this time, many places in our region are enjoying a return to some sense of normalcy. Therefore, we are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation in the Archdiocese of Baltimore, the Archdiocese of Washington, and the Dioceses of Arlington, Richmond, Wheeling-Charleston, and Wilmington and reinstating that obligation beginning on Saturday, June 26, 2021 and Sunday, June 27, 2021. We welcome and encourage the Faithful to return to full in-person participation of the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law, canon 1246-1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180). This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus, another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult his or her local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (Canon 1245 and the Catechism of the Catholic Church n. 2181). Safety protocols and other liturgical directives in each diocese remain in effect until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop. Let us continue to be united in prayer for one another and for an end to the global pandemic.

70 OVER 70 – Recently, there was an article in the Washington Post written by Margaret Sullivan describing a new podcast called "70 Over 70" created by Max Linksy. It was inspired by Andre De Shields, who, at 73 years of age, received his first Tony Award in 2019. Rather than trying to thank dozens of people in a traditional acceptance speech, he shared the three cardinal rules of his "sustainability and longevity," calling them "wisdom bombs." He said, "One, surround yourself with people whose eyes light up when they see you coming. Two, slowly is the fastest way to get to where you want to be. And three, the top of the mountain is the bottom of the next. So keep climbing."

Lansky's brainchild is encouraging accomplished seniors to deliver more wisdom bombs in his new podcast as he interviews guests such as Norman Lear, Dionne Warwick, Dan Rather, James E. Clyburn, and others. His conversation with Sister Helen Prejean, the 82-year-old death-penalty-fighting Roman Catholic nun, was the centerpiece of the first episode. Although the guest list is diverse, common themes have emerged. Almost all talked about the importance of being fully present in the moment. (Thank you, St. Francis de Sales!)

The website link for "70 Over 70" is https://pineapple.fm/70-over-70. If you scroll down to the little forward-pointing arrow, you should be able to listen to the first episode right there. If you return to the same website next week, a new episode will be there. There's also a way to subscribe to the product, so it gets sent to you. (Thank you, Margaret Sullivan!)




