

## VIRTUAL ACADEMY – HIGH SCHOOL

### Course Offerings

CCPS Virtual Academy is committed to supporting the academic needs and interests of its high school level students. The school's goal is to offer graduation required courses, some Advanced Placement (AP) courses, and select electives. Not all courses offered in a traditional school setting will be offered in the Virtual Academy. All courses will have a required synchronous component. The number of required synchronous sessions will be determined on a course-by-course basis. Courses that will always be offered include:

- Fine Art credit: Music appreciation
- Tech Ed credit: Foundations of Technology
- Other Graduation Requirements: Financial Literacy, Health, Physical Education
- World Language: Spanish
- English: 9,10,11,12 and Comp and Rhetoric
- Social Studies: US History, Government, World History
- Science: Biology, Matter and Energy, Chemistry, Earth Science
- Math: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Statistics
- Electives: Creative Writing, Computer Keyboarding for College and Careers, Physics, Honors Environmental, Psychology, Sociology
- Computer Science Pathway: Foundations of Computer Science, AP Computer Science Principals, App Development, Ap Computer Science Coding
- Student course selections will determine if we will be able to offer additional courses or AP courses.
