Campus

Due to summer construction, our camp will not have a traditional campus. The Marriott field next to Aidan will serve as our primary meeting and activity space. Our camp will use the 2nd floor of Aidan's "Annex" space as our go-to bathroom and medical locations. We will also use the Annex as a temporary classroom for occasional indoor activities. Daily Arrival

Campers may arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 a.m. Please meet us at the Marriott field. In the event of inclement weather, please meet us at the entrance of Aidan's "Annex", where campers will be directed to the 2nd floor. Parents will be notified ahead of time if we will need to meet at the Annex.

Daily Dismissal

Dismissal will be held between 3:30 and 3:45 p.m. Location will be the same as arrival: the Marriott field is the primary space; the Annex is the backup space. Parents will be notified ahead of time if we will need to meet at the Annex.

Daily Pack List

Students must pack the following items on a DAILY BASIS:

- A backpack (to carry many of the ensuing items!)
- Sunscreen and a hat for sun protection
- 2 full water bottles, labelled with camper's name
- Lunch and snack in a non-perishable bag
- Rain jacket
- Campers must WEAR durable, close-toed shoes each day!
- At least one extra mask
- Hand sanitizer and/or cleaning wipes for hands

Other Packing Notes:

- On rainy days, children should pack rain boots.
- We will have plenty of chances for water refills, bathroom breaks (with hand washing), and masks breaks! We will also have clorox wipes on hand for cleaning purposes.
- Parents will be notified ahead of time for any days with specialized packing lists
- Children may absolutely bring a book or journal with them for potentially long bus rides.

After Care

Unfortunately, there will be no after-care program this summer. Please text or call Phillip (202-277-6727) if you are running late at pickup time.

Attendance

Official attendance will be taken each morning at 9 a.m. (arrival is 8:30 to 8:45 a.m.). We typically won't leave for any field trips until after 9 a.m., but please be mindful of the day's schedule!

Health Center

If your child needs to take medications during camp hours or requires any rescue medication, please bring it (clearly labelled!) to camp on Monday morning of each week of camp. We will keep the medication in our traveling first-aid kit.

For any medical questions or concerns, please reach directly out to Phillip or Aidan's nurse, Lexi Pollack. *Please note that Nurse Lexi's summer work days are on Tuesdays only.*

Waivers

Please note that some events may require waivers to be filled out. Parents/guardians will be notified ahead of time with any required waivers for the week.

Water Bottles

Each child should come to camp with at least two full water bottles. Please label them with your child's name.

COVID and Camp, Aidan Explorers 2021

It is our primary goal to create a safe and healthy camp environment. In order to mitigate the risk of COVID-19, Aidan Explorers will take the following precautions:

Bus

We will consistently have all windows on the bus open to help circulate the air. The seats, railings, and windows of the bus will be cleaned and sanitized daily.

Cleaning

We will continue to adhere to the CDC and DC DoH recommended cleaning and sanitizing protocols throughout the day.

Distancing

Proper physical distancing among campers and faculty will continue to be maintained as they have been during the school year. Distance may be temporarily and incidentally lessened during the ebb and flow of the camp day.

Magnus App

We will continue using the Magnus app every morning for all campers attending camp. Because dropoff will usually be off-campus, parents must show the completed Magnus app each morning at dropoff time. Temperature checks will also continue at dropoff time.

Masks

Masks will be required throughout the camp day. We will provide plenty of spaced-out mask breaks, especially when outside. We will follow the guidelines at each field trip location to ensure we are using the best and safest practices for mask-wearing. Masks may be removed during very rare activities, specifically those involving water, as we would not want to put any children in danger. Parents will be communicated ahead of time regarding these outstanding instances.

Testing

All campers are required to test negative for COVID within 72 hours of starting camp. Campers will have to be tested at the beginning of their first week of camp. Testing is not required for any following *consecutive* weeks. However, campers must test negative again to return to camp for any nonconsecutive weeks.

e.g. If a camper is enrolled for weeks 1 and 4, he/she will need a negative test before week 1 AND week 4. If a camper is enrolled for weeks 1, 2, 3, and 4, he/she will only need a negative test before week 1.

Travel

Children will still have to adhere to the DC DoH travel guidelines that state they must quarantine upon arrival back to DC for 3-5 days, get tested, and have the results back before re-entering society/summer camp.

With the ever changing guidelines from CDC and DoH, these mitigations are subject to change, but families will be alerted of any changes made. We will continue to seek guidance from CDC and DoH to make sure we are following the safest practices for our campers and families.
