### **A. Verb Review**

Each assigned practice must be completed before midnight on the due date. You may submit them at any time during the week for which they are assigned – **NOT** any earlier. If you will be on vacation or away from Internet access, please inform me via email and we will arrange a due date for those practices.

Directions:

Go to the website [www.conjugemos.com](http://www.conjugemos.com). Your “Student sign in” information is the following: Username: **firstname.lastname** – exactly the same as your school email (**without** the @saintjosephprep.org). Password: **sjspanish2021** (\*NOTE: this is changed from last year) – no capital letters.

**For each assigned practice you should set the timer for 10 minutes.** The number of vocabulary words or verbs you should “attempt” and the minimum percent you need to earn are listed below in the chart. **Please only submit your score ONCE.** If you are at the deadline and haven’t met the minimum, be sure to submit your best score.

**For the verb practice,** navigate to the “Spanish verbs” section. The numbers in the chart refer to the practice numbers – check these carefully!

During the verb practice, you **MAY NOT** click on “Verb Chart”. I recommend that, before you start the practice, you study the verbs by looking at the “Conjugation Chart” on the home page.

verbs: 75 verbs attempted & 85% or better correct

You **MUST** be logged in to complete these exercises. The site will NOT keep you logged in forever. **In order to check if you are logged in, look in the upper righthand corner and be sure that it says your name.** If you see this note, it means that you are logged in.

If you reach the minimum number of verbs AND the minimum percent correct before the 10 minutes are up, you may stop the practice. However you may want to continue to try and improve your percentage.

**Once you have completed each exercise** you will see a note that states “All Done!” It will give your score and your average percentage. It asks “Save Your Score?”, click on OK. You will see a note in red that states “Your grade has been recorded”.

**B. Leer, Escuchar y Hablar** - for this section, create one (1) google doc & title it “your name summer work Spanish 4H” and SHARE it with me

### 1. Leer

Navigate to [www.prensaescrita.com](http://www.prensaescrita.com). Choose a country and choose a newspaper, – you **MUST** choose newspapers from different countries for these 3 assignments. Once on the newspaper website choose an article to **read** and copy the web address of the article to include in your google doc.

**You must** choose an article from a different theme for EACH of your three (3) summaries, written in Spanish, – choose from the following categories:

1. Global Challenges
2. Science & Technology
3. Contemporary Life
4. Personal & Public Identities
5. Families & Communities
6. Beauty & Aesthetics

### 2. Escuchar

There are 3 of these types of questions. Navigate to <http://www.spanishlistening.org/> Select by: Level. Select a Level: Intermediate. Select a Topic: *you choose*.

You **MUST** choose different topics for each listening (video).

In your summary, copy the web address of the listening (video) and include it in your google doc.

You **MUST** "hide" the transcript, but you may listen two (2) times. Please **DO NOT** look at the transcript!

### 3. Hablar

I will send you a question via email on Aug 13 and Sept 3. Call 978--8BACON7 (822--2667) and respond to the question. Before you respond, say “Soy (your name)”. You may write bullet points to refer to when you respond. You **MAY NOT** write out a complete script and read it as your response.

You should make every effort to make your response last at least one (1) minute.
