

Marin County COVID-19 Safety - Decision Tree for Schools - Tier 4 | Yellow

(Effective 6/2/2021: Subject to Change: Below Decision Tree is the Same as Former Tier 3 Orange)

If a student (under 18 years old) has **any** of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath / difficulty breathing, loss of smell or taste, fever $\geq 100.4^\circ$ F or chills, sore throat or diarrhea

If a staff / household member (18 years old and over) has **any** of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath / difficulty breathing, loss of smell or taste, fever $\geq 100.4^\circ$ F or chills, body ache, fatigue, headache, congestion / runny nose, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting.

*****Anyone (except fully vaccinated persons)** who has engaged in high-risk activities or out-of-state travel should quarantine for 10 days and monitor for symptoms for 14 days. If any symptoms develop, they should immediately self-isolate and test. Quarantine may be discontinued after 7 days with a negative test (antigen or molecular) completed on Day 5 or later if they remain asymptomatic.

If a student (under 18 years old) has **any** of the following symptoms: body ache, fatigue, headache, congestion / runny nose, nausea or vomiting **If a school nurse suspects COVID-19, they may require a healthcare provider evaluation.*

Siblings & household contacts need to stay home (or will be sent home) until negative COVID-19 test confirmed. **Fully vaccinated persons and asymptomatic essential workers do not need to quarantine but should monitor for symptoms. If any symptoms develop, they should immediately self-isolate & test.*

Siblings & household members do not need to stay home

Symptomatic students and staff **MUST** Schedule COVID-19 test ("**Test or 10**") or healthcare provider evaluation

COVID-19 NEGATIVE or alternate diagnosis (e.g., migraine, strep throat)

Return to school after symptoms improved **AND** fever-free for > 24 hours w/o fever reducing medications **OR** with copy of negative COVID test result **OR** communication from healthcare provider that student / staff may return to school **AND** fever-free for > 24 hours w/o fever reducing medications

COVID-19 POSITIVE or not tested

ISOLATE: Stay at home for 10 days from time symptoms started (or date of positive test) until **feeling better AND** fever-free for > 24 hours w/o fever reducing meds

Siblings & household contacts must stay home; schedule COVID-19 test 5 days after last contact; and follow Updated Quarantine Orders

COVID-19 POSITIVE or not tested

Follow Updated Quarantine Orders: Exposed person(s), except fully vaccinated persons, should quarantine for 10 days and monitor for symptoms for 14 days. If any symptoms develop, they should immediately self-isolate and test. Quarantine may be discontinued after 7 days with a negative test (antigen or molecular) completed on Day 5 or later if they remain asymptomatic.

Exposure to COVID-19 positive person: Spent 15 minutes or more within 6 feet of an infected person (with or without mask) or lives in the same household with someone who tested positive for COVID-19

Siblings and household members do not need to stay home *if the exposed person can quarantine from household members or if fully vaccinated*

Exposed person should schedule COVID-19 test 5 days after last contact with positive case or when they develop symptoms
