If you choose to pay online with a credit card at time of registration, once payment is complete, upload a screenshot of the receipt to the Online Registration Form. You may also register online and pay by mailing in a check. Completely fill out the 2021 registration form online and upload any required documents. Make payment online through June 17. If you have chosen to register online but not pay online, please make sure you mail your check, postmarked by June 14 and include your student's full name on the check. If you do not have internet access or if you choose, you may still register on the paper registration form and pay by check.

Elementary Summer School will consist of a 3½ hour instructional day for students. Classes meet Monday through Friday. All classes will cover core content; reading, writing, and math. Each class will be a preparatory class for the next grade level. For example: Pre-2nd will focus on skills for students that just completed first grade and will be entering second grade in fall 2021.

If you want your student to take classes for a grade level above their current grade level, the student’s current principal or counselor **MUST** sign the registration form (page A).

Additionally, each teacher will teach an elective class. Groups of students will experience a variety of fun and engaging classes. Pre-1st, Pre-2nd, and Pre-3rd teachers will work together to provide the elective rotation for their primary group of students. Pre-4th, Pre-5th, and Pre-6th teachers will work together to provide the elective rotation for their intermediate group of students.

Transportation

Parents will be responsible for transportation of their student to and from summer school for Elementary Core Academic (Rockwell).

Enrichment Summer School Class Information

Elementary Summer Camps

(Current kindergarten through 4th grade students)

This year, there are three 9- or 10-day enrichment opportunities. They are STEM Camp (coding, robotics, and engineering design), Drama Camp (theater, stage, and performance), and Integrated Art/Writing Experience (multi-medium art with varied writing approaches). There are two sessions for these opportunities:

Summer camp sessions are not continuous; the material covered in Session 1 and Session 2 is the same.

STEM Camp

Session I: July 6–16 and Session II: July 19-30

These courses are designed for students currently in grades K-4th. STEM Camp will meet from 8:30 a.m.-noon each day. Participants will explore a variety of STEM-based learning experiences to include the engineering design process, maker spaces and coding.

Drama Camp

Session I: July 6–16 and Session II: July 19-30

These courses are designed for students currently in grades K-4th. Drama Camp will meet from 8:30 a.m.-noon each day. Participants will explore foundations of stage performance to include auditions, rehearsals, role/character development, costuming and live stage performance. Drama Camp culminates with a performance for families.

Integrated Art/Writing Workshop Camp

Session I: July 6–16 and Session II: July 19-30

These courses are designed for students currently in grades K-4th. Integrated Art/Writing Workshop will meet from 8:30 a.m.-noon each day. Participants will create works of art via watercolor, color pencil, charcoal, etc. and then develop creative writing pieces based on their art. Integrated Art/Writing Workshop culminates with the development of a take home anthology.

Transportation

Parents will be responsible for transportation of their student to and from summer school for Elementary Enrichment Camps (Keller).

NO MIDDLE SCHOOL DIGIPEN IN SUMMER 2021

LWSD does not have the capacity to offer Middle School DigiPen during the 2021 Summer School session.

Reduced Fees

The Lake Washington School District Board of Directors has determined that **current** LWSD resident students who qualify for free or reduced lunch at their home school during the current school year also qualify for reduced Summer School tuition subject to the following guidelines:

1. **Free and reduced forms are NOT available during walk-in or late Summer School registration.**
2. LWSD must verify students' free or reduced lunch status. Please have the student's current school official verify on the registration form prior to submitting it. Or you may contact Sara Peterson sapeterson@lwsd.org if you cannot reach your current school official, and obtain a Free and Reduced form. After submitting the form to sapeterson@lwsd.org, you will receive a verification letter that must be included with your registration form if you are eligible.
3. Fee for LWSD residents with free lunch status:
 - **Core Academic** \$225 - 19-day session
 - **Summer Camps** Session 1 \$101 (9-day session)/ Session 2 \$113 (10-day session)
4. Fee for LWSD residents with reduced lunch status:
 - **Core Academic** \$300 - 19-day session
 - **Summer Camps** Session 1 \$135 (9-day session)/ Session 2 \$150 (10-day session)

Fee Refunds

The course fee will be refunded if a course is cancelled. **NO refunds will be approved once Summer School classes have begun (after July 6, 2021).**

Course Cancellations

Summer School is a self-supporting program dependent on student fees. Courses that fail to achieve minimum enrollment may be cancelled or combined. Parents will be notified of cancellations and fees will be refunded as soon as possible, usually in two to four weeks. We will make the final determination for classes, based on enrollment.

The on-site Elementary Summer School Secretary will notify all parents if summer classes are cancelled before the first day of Summer School.

Special Services

Support and accommodations for students with IEPs (Individualized Education Plans) or 504s are provided differently in Summer School. The staff aims to meet the needs of all students; we review current information on your child's IEP or 504 plan to better understand strategies, classroom accommodations, or assignment modifications that allow your child to be successful in a regular classroom environment. Pull-out services for Specially Designed Instruction are not part of the Elementary Summer School program.

Medical Information

Please list on the registration form any important medical information for your child. This might include medical conditions and/or medications the student may need to take during the school day, for example, for allergies, migraines, etc.

An LWSD Medical Authorization Form **MUST** be completed by a doctor before any medications can be given during the school day. Medical authorization forms are available at your home school and **MUST** be turned in with your registration forms. Medication to be given during school hours by a trained staff member must be brought to the Summer School office on the first day of Summer School.
