Strongsville Schools "Excellence in Athletics" Fundraising Effort Receives \$100,000 Donation

Strongsville City Schools announced a second lead gift in the ongoing "Excellence in Athletics" fundraising effort. The Pat Catan Family is donating \$100,000 to purchase a new state-of-the-art scoreboard for use at Pat Catan Stadium. The Catan family has a long history of supporting Strongsville City Schools, including past donations to build Pat Catan Stadium.

"My family and I are thrilled to donate the funds needed for a new scoreboard," said Mike Catan. "Our goal has always been to have the best facility possible for the children of Strongsville. I appreciate the current school board's efforts in making sure this remains a first class facility!"

The Catan donation supports the "Excellence in Athletics" campaign, a group of local volunteers who are raising private funds to install synthetic turf at Strongsville Middle School and Pat Catan Stadium, as well as upgrade athletic facilities. The volunteers hope to raise funds this year so the turf is ready for the 2016-17 school year. The private fundraising effort offers corporate naming rights to stadium areas such as the field, end zones, scoreboard, locker rooms, and spectator stands sections.

"The Catan family's commitment to Strongsville City Schools is a huge asset for both our District and for our entire community," said Superintendent Cameron M. Ryba. "We are fortunate and very thankful for their ongoing support and dedication to supporting our district and our students."
