Athletic Update - Fall Sports Roundup

Girls Tennis The girls tennis team finished with an overall record of 13-6 and 4-3 in the Greater Cleveland Conference. Overall the team finished in 4th place in the GCC out of 8 teams. The team was a sectional qualifier.

Girls Golf The girls golf team had a great season in a very competitive conference. The team finished 2nd overall in the GCC and also had a district qualifier this year.

Boys Golf The boys golf team finished 4th overall in the GCC. Highlights included finishing 3rd out of 16 at the Elyria Invitational as well as the Midview Invitational. The team

concluded its season finishing 6th out of 17 teams at the sectional to just miss out on qualifying for district competition.

Cross Country The cross country teams both had great seasons. The girls team qualified for the regional tournament and ended up finishing 9th. The boys team qualified two individuals to the regional tournament. In conference action, both teams finished 4th overall.

Football The football team finished with a record of 5-5 and unfortunately missed qualifying for the OHSAA playoffs by 1 spot. The team finished the season off on a high note by beating rival Brunswick in the last game of the year. Congratulations to the 9th grade football team as they finished the season 10-0.

Girls Soccer The girls soccer won this year's district championship and ultimately ended their season in the regional semi-final with a tough 2-1 loss in double overtime to Walsh Jesuit High School. The final record for the girls team this year was 15-2-3.

Boys Soccer The boys soccer team also won a district championship this year and ultimately lost in the regional championship game to St. John's Jesuit, 2-0. The team had a fantastic run through the postseason and finished with a record of 13-5-3.
