Google Apps for Education Student Gmail Accounts. By the end of August, Strongsville City Schools will open our *Google Apps for Education* Gmail accounts for students in grades K-12. We are excited to bring this technology to our students as a learning tool. Curriculum Update. Students in grades K-5 will be using a new math program this year called *Go Math!* This program offers an engaging and interactive approach to learning math. One unique feature of this program is that it includes a write-in book so students can solve and practice problems right in their own workbook. There is also an online portion that allows parents and students to watch instructional videos on any lesson to help strengthen concepts and skills. Each student will receive a username and password in order to access online content such as personalized practice, homework and assessments. We are excited to bring *Go Math!* to our students and know that this adoption will provide a strong mathematics foundation for our elementary school students.

School Construction Updates

High School At the high school we have completed phase I and phase II of the construction plan. This includes 66 classrooms, several restrooms and teacher work rooms. These areas received new windows, roof systems, new flooring, fresh paint and each classroom has a comprehensive technology package including wireless and a sound assist system. The staff and students were excited to see the updated rooms when school started on August 12th. Phase III and IV are currently under construction and the project is on schedule.

Middle School The third floor of the middle school instructional wing is taking shape. The interior wall framing is almost complete on the second floor with the mechanical systems to follow. Installation of the roof structure will begin by September 1st for the instructional wing and we will begin to see the outline of the final structure.

Financial Update

As many of you have heard, the most recent State budget resulted in Strongsville City Schools losing over \$6 million in the next 3 years. During the August 16, 2015 Board of Education work session, Tony Podojil from the Alliance for High Quality Education presented about the potential benefits of joining their group, which currently includes 68 school districts. The major benefit of joining the Alliance is a shared consistent message to legislators. The School Board will decide if Strongsville City Schools will join the Alliance. Superintendent Ryba and Members of the Board of Education have said that they will continue to fight for additional state funding to help ensure a quality education for our students.
