Community Service Hours Are a Graduation Requirement

90 hours of community service are required for graduation from CCDS (for students enrolled grades 9-12). Most students far exceed this number. While we value all opportunities to make a difference, we make a distinction between **volunteer hours** and **service hours**. Our goal is to encourage students to stretch and challenge their normal routines and associations, which is why we honor both types of giving back: Volunteerism and Service to others.

Volunteer Hours include working at one's place of worship, assisting at CCDS events, helping on a political campaign, being an unpaid counselor at a private camp, etc. **Up to 30** of the 90 required hours can be volunteer hours.

Service Hours involve direct participation with underserved populations such as individuals with disabilities, older adults, and people experiencing homelessness, poverty, and illness. Service can also be in the interest of improving the living conditions of animals or working to better the environment. **A minimum of 60** of the 90 hours required for graduation must be service hours. There is no maximum number of service hours.

Note: Students attending CCDS' Annual Community Service Days will receive 5 Service Hours for each Service Day.

Verification of Hours

To earn credit for community service hours, students must upload their service hours to their account on my.innerview.org and the Director of Service Learning will approve them. All uploaded hours **MUST** have the name and email OR phone number to contact the supervisor.

Note: If any of this information is missing, the hours will not be verified until correct information is given. The supervisor cannot be a family member.

Students new to the Upper School

A my.innerview.org account will be set up for you in the fall. If you do service work during the summer of 2021, please complete the Hours Verification form at the end of this note.

Suggested Schedule for Requirement Completion

Assuming students will earn 20 Service Hours by attending four CCDS Service Days, below is a suggested (but not required) schedule to help students keep "on track" for the remaining 70 hours. Freshmen can accrue hours the summer before 9th grade

9 th grade year: 15 hours	11 th grade year: 20 hours
10 th grade year: 15 hours	12 th grade year: 20 hours
