Community: Karns City Area School District is a public school in Pennsylvania serving students from Armstrong, Butler, and Clarion counties. There are two elementary schools, Chicora and Sugarcreek, and one Junior-Senior High School. The total enrollment for the district is 1,390.

School Description: Karns City Junior-Senior High School is committed to excellence and provides students with academically challenging courses and a wide variety of extracurricular activities to prepare them for the twenty-first century. A dedicated faculty, administration, and staff strive to maintain high standards.

Curriculum: The school year consists of two 18-week semesters. All classes meet five days a week for 41 minutes. The regular school day consists of nine class periods. The comprehensive special education program offers all classes that are needed for students who qualify. 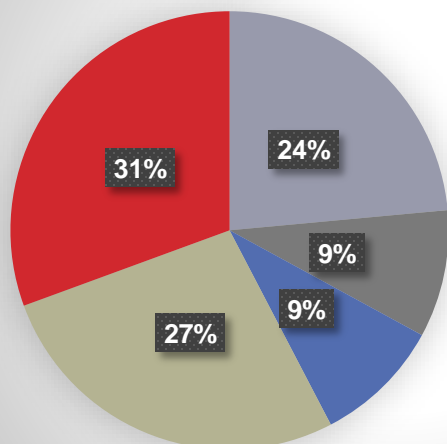
