Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)

- Purpose
 - *School districts are required to engage parents, students, teachers, administrators, and other school personnel to develop, adopt, and annually update a three-year LCAP that describes how the district will spend funds and outlines the goals for improving student outcomes in accordance with eight priorities set by the State of California.*
- Began in 2013 in conjunction with the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)
- Implementation in FUHSD
