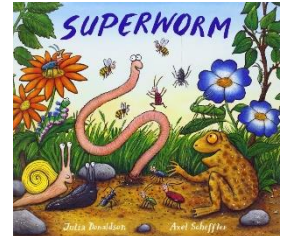


Dear Nursery Parents,
