

4th Grade Required Summer Reading Assignment (For Returning Students)

Use the attached Bingo board to guide your reading and writing work over the summer. Directions can be found at the top of the board. An adult should initial each square after the activity is completed.

Before school restarts in the fall, choose one book that you read in order to complete the bingo board. Think of something you can bring in to school to represent that reading.

For example:

- *Did you like book because of the characters? Draw a picture of the main character in the book and bring it to class.*
- *Does the setting make you think of a place that you go? Bring in something that you have from that place.*
- *Do you have something in common with one of the characters? Bring in something that represents that similarity.*
