- Bob Morley of Pompton Plains does not support relocating special education students. He does not want to see siblings separated. He feels that the achievement gap in the elementary schools is widening. He spoke against armed security guards in school in the event the weapon is accidentally discharged.
- Mike Carfello of Pequannock spoke in favor of youth lacrosse, stating that football should not be the only priority.
