MULTIPLE STUDENT TUITION DISCOUNT of \$1,000 will be applied to the second and third students enrolled. *\*\* This discount will not apply if any student is receiving a scholarship or other award valued at 50% of tuition or higher (excluding EdChoice or Jon Peterson scholarships).*

FULL PAYMENT DISCOUNT of \$200 is given when payment in full is made by May 15, 2021. *\*\* This discount does not apply for students receiving a scholarship or other award valued at 50% of tuition or higher.*

DEPOSIT and REGISTRATION FEE of \$850 are due at registration and are **non-refundable**. Schedules will be issued for students with completed enrollment contracts and paid deposit and registration fee only. For incoming freshman the deposit and registration fees are due on Commitment Day which is January 28, 2021. Returning student's deposit and registration fees are due by February 28, 2021.

TABLET Tablet fee of \$1900 includes tablet and software while the student is at McNicholas. Freshmen may pay this fee over four years. Ownership is transferred to the student/family after all fees are paid upon graduation or withdrawal.

VISA / MASTERCARD / DISCOVER / AMERICAN EXPRESS credit cards will be accepted for registration deposits (*applicable fees apply*).

LATE REGISTRATION FEE of \$350 is charged if a current student is not registered by February 28, 2021.

S. A. I. L. FEE of \$5,375 for students enrolled in this program. This fee is in addition to the above tuition charges. McNicholas High School is a provider for students who qualify for the State of Ohio Jon Peterson Special Needs Scholarship Program.

TUITION PAYMENTS FACTS Tuition Management, a third-party service, is the billing agent for all tuition payments. New families must create a McNicholas FACTS payment account and choose a Payment Plan. Please see reverse side for financing option details.

## FACTS TUITION PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

McNicholas High School offers four payment plan options. FACTS Tuition Management, a third-party service, is the billing agent for all tuition payments.

1. **Full payment** - Parents may choose to pay the annual tuition and fees due prior to or by May 15, 2021. A \$200 discount is issued per student with the pay in full option. *\*\* This discount does not apply for students receiving a scholarship or other award valued at 50% of tuition or higher.*
2. **Two-Pay Plan** – Parents may choose to pay the annual tuition and fees in two (2) payments with a 2% finance charge added. The first payment is in May 2021 and the second payment is in November 2021.
3. **Four-Pay Plan** – Parents may choose to pay the annual tuition and fees in four (4) payments with a 3% finance charge added. Payments are due May 2021, September 2021, December 2021, and March 2022.
4. **Ten-Pay Plan** - Parents may choose to pay the annual tuition and fees in ten (10) monthly payments with a 5% finance charge added, beginning in July 2021 and ending April 2022.

FACTS will not charge an annual service fee when paying in full. Annual service fees of \$10 for the two-pay plan and \$43 for the four and ten pay plans, will be charged. FACTS reserves the right to assess a fee for checks returned and fees for credit card use with payment plans.

\*McNicholas will add incoming freshmen, who are younger siblings of current students, to the FACTS account.
