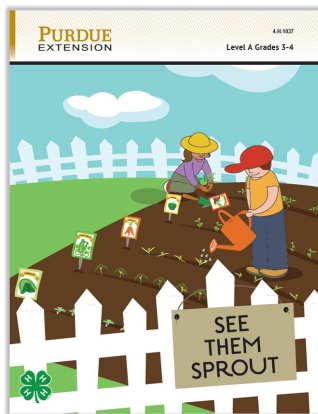
Join Our Hybrid Special Interest 4-H Club!
