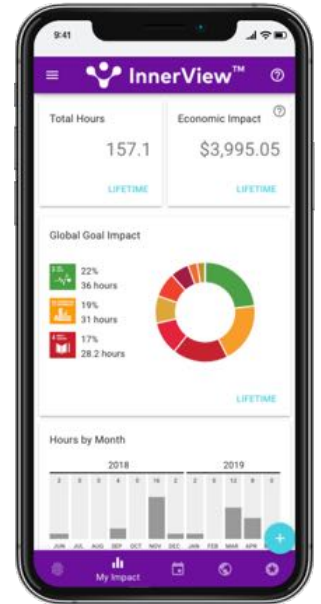
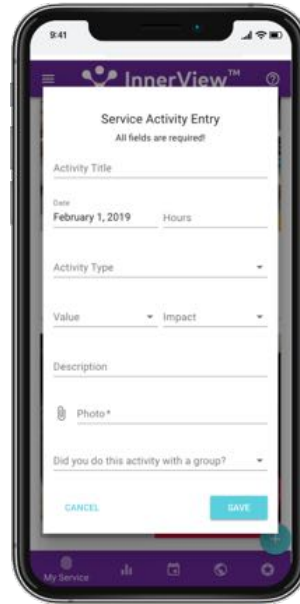

How do I add an activity?

Click the blue + button in the bottom right corner to add an activity. You can add things from the past by using the calendar widget to pick the appropriate date.

What if I don't have a photo for an activity?

All service activities require at least one photo - the best are action shots that help others see YOU dedicating your time and effort to things that are important to you. In cases where it might be inappropriate to take a photo with the people you're helping (ie. children under 13 or patients in a hospital), you can get creative and take a selfie in front of the building or before others arrive.

How do I enter service activities that I do regularly?

If you do the same activity regularly, like volunteering at a summer camp every day for a week or tutoring every Wednesday during the school year, it's up to you whether you create one entry that covers all of that service or whether you create a separate entry for each day. If you find yourself writing the exact same description and using the exact same photo over and over, consider grouping them all into one entry, or perhaps one entry to cover a month or a semester's worth of that activity. This is your Service Resume; think about how you want to tell your story.

How can I tell if my activities have been confirmed?

If your school is confirming hours on InnerView, you'll see an icon next to each activity showing whether it's been confirmed or dismissed. If there is no icon, it hasn't been reviewed yet.

If your school Service Leader identifies an issue with one of your activities, you will get an email notification. You have the opportunity to correct any activity that's been dismissed - you can see the reason when you expand the details for the activity.

How do I tag an activity to a specific group?

You must be a member of the group to see it as an option to tag. When you add or edit an activity, the last field on the form asks "Did you do this with a group?". Select the group that you want to tag from that list.

How do I apply for an award?

You are automatically considered for all of the active awards programs on InnerView by adding your service. You will be notified via email when you earn any award.

Can I update my email address or school?

Yes. Your InnerView account belongs to you and you can take it with you when you leave this school. In your profile menu there are options to update your email address and school.

Is there an InnerView app?

When students visit my.InnerView.org in Safari on their iPhone or Chrome on their Android, they'll be prompted to install InnerView as an app. There is no app listed in the App Store or Play Store.

What should I use for my profile photo?

You can use your Service Resume to stand out when applying for jobs, scholarships and for college. To look your best, we recommend a clear photo of your face.

If you earn an award, in order to qualify for all of the awards recognition, you must have a publishable profile photo (clearly shows your face, no filters - something you'd be proud to show a potential employer).

How do I access my Service Resume?

From Artifacts in your profile menu, you can grab the link to the public view of your Service Resume or download it as a PDF.
