CHANGES TO START AND FINISH TIMES

The changes to our start and finish times have been wellreceived by the majority of parents and are making a big difference to how we support the children within the academy.

However, there is understandably some concern from many of you about the congestion at drop off and pick up times.

We will do everything we can to ensure that classes are dismissed on time each day, including where siblings are using different entrances to their class. In return, we ask that you please help us with the following:

- Please do not stand and socialise within the academy grounds or around the entrances (just drop/ collect and go)
- Please do not come on site until 5 minutes before the allotted time, and allow the class before you to go first.

We have done so well with managing Covid cases and if we work together we can continue to ensure that the risk of transmission within the academy is minimal.

Supporting your child with Good Attendance

Please help your child by making sure that they arrive at school on time each day and are not collected early.

This not only affects their attendance but can also make it harder for them to learn and to make friends.



Where possible, please make medical appointments outside of school hours. Parents needing to collect children early must complete a request form in advance.
