


Current Situation: COVID-19 Cases


NC Counties by Tier: Data from May 23 - June 5, 2021












People Vaccinated with at Least One Dose: 63,746 NC residents missing county information; 79,951 out of state residents























Community Quarantine and Isolation Guidance

<u>Quarantine</u>: tool we have to separate individuals who have been exposed from other individuals to reduce or prevent the spread of disease.

Close contacts:

- You were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more
- You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
- You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
- You shared eating or drinking utensils
- They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you

Close contacts are determined through a process call case investigation and contact tracing.

Current Quarantine Guidance for Rowan County:

After day 7 from last day of exposure <u>AND</u> you have received a negative test result at day 5 or later. Must continue to monitor symptoms.

*Congregate living facilities like nursing homes and correction facilities due to high potential for spread must maintain the 14-day.

Key Points

Spring 2021 Data

- After implementation of Plan A (4 days per week in person), COVID cases and quarantine numbers spiked but reduced to nearly pre-Plan A levels.
- Greater number of employees are vaccinated.

Summer School Pilot

- 4 per week June
- 5 per week July
- Precautions
 - Masks Required
 - 6ft Social Distancing
 - Nurses and Health Techs Employed

To return to a 5 day per week in person schedule

for the 2021-2022 school year.
