Summary Annual Report

FOR OREGON EPISCOPAL SCHOOL GROUP DENTAL PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Oregon Episcopal School Group Dental Plan, EIN 93-0386915, Plan No. 504, for period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The plan has contracts with Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Northwest, Willamette Dental Insurance, Inc to pay Dental, claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2020 were \$103,428.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2020, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$39,935 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$15,541.
