



## Summer Armadillo Community Agreements

Health authorities have reiterated throughout the COVID-19 global pandemic that the health of every community depends on the actions of all individuals within that community. We recognize that the safety of our community is also dependent on a [layered approach](#) with a variety of risk mitigation efforts. As we host in-person summer camps, we ask that students and families at OES commit to the following:

- ❑ Read the [COVID-19 OES Understanding of Risks](#).
- ❑ Monitor my student's health and complete the OES health screening survey each morning before leaving home.
- ❑ Keep my student home if they or any household member has one or more [symptoms of COVID-19](#), or if my student has been exposed to someone with a diagnosed or presumptive case of COVID-19.
- ❑ Contact [Summer at OES](#) immediately if a student or household pod member is diagnosed with COVID-19.
- ❑ Prepare by having my student equipped with two clean, multi-layered cloth [face coverings](#) or surgical masks when they are on campus.
- ❑ Observe all health/safety protocols while on campus, including frequent hand washing, wearing a mask indoors and outdoors unless instructed otherwise by a teacher, and maintaining a distance from others of at least six feet whenever possible.
- ❑ Alert an OES employee if sickness occurs while on campus and proceed immediately to the isolation room. Parents will be required to pick up students promptly.
- ❑ [Avoid non-essential travel](#), and adhere to OES's [requirements for post-travel quarantine](#) if my student does travel.
- ❑ Limit our [household exposure](#) by minimizing the indoor social interactions of each household member to a small group of people.
- ❑ [Avoid social indoor gatherings](#) and crowds, follow OHA guidelines whenever possible.
- ❑ Adhere to recommended health and safety guidelines including masks and physical distancing when interacting with people outside of our household bubble.
- ❑ Understand that if we do not uphold these commitments, my student(s) may not be allowed on campus for a period of time as determined by the OES administration.
- ❑ Understand that these protocols may change as health experts' guidance about preventing the spread of COVID-19 evolves.
