### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to consider the options of those persons in the schools and/or the community who are not directly involved in the selection process of resource materials.

Any district resident or district employee may raise objection to resource materials used in the district's educational program, despite the fact that the individuals selecting such resources were duly qualified to make the selection, followed the proper procedure and observed the criteria for selecting resource materials in question. However, no parent/guardian has the right to determine the appropriateness of resource materials for students other than his/her own children.

The Assistant Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy whereby a district resident or a district employee may formally challenge resource materials used in the district's educational program on the basis of appropriateness by submitting a complaint.

The decision of the Board is binding for all district schools as it relates to the resource materials in question.
