This year, we are asking all members of our connected community to go that one degree further and experience achievements that they never thought were possible.

We look forward to expanding opportunities to build and nurture a connected community that is filled with strong partnerships and productive relationships designed to improve the educational outcomes for every Mashpee student while also enriching the lives of all involved. One such partnership is with the Masonic Angels organization. They recently donated school supplies for all of our Mashpee learners (PreK – 12). Each school received notebooks, pocket folders, composition books, glue sticks, crayons, colored pencils, pencil sharpeners, erasers, pencil boxes, and more. With this generous donation, students in need will also be provided with supplies for homework. The Masonic Angels are also supporting the “Quashnet Cares” program, which was formed last year to provide supplemental food and household items to Quashnet families in need. One component of this program provides students with food to consume when they are not in school (weekends and

vacations). It costs \$150 per year to sponsor a qualifying child. All donations are tax-deductible. If you would like to make a donation or learn more about the program, please contact Mrs. Jane Emery or Principal MaryKate O'Brien at the Quashnet School. Through their Bee Hive program, the Masonic Angels have committed to supplying this program with food products and nonperishable items twice a month. The Kiwanis Club of Mashpee has also made a commitment to support ten students per year for the next three years. These are examples of the benefits of being a connected community where everyone is working together to ensure the best possible outcomes.

We are grateful for the opportunity we have been given to serve the families of Mashpee. Through our use of a multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) framework, every student has access to instruction, curriculum, and an environment that ensures achievement of his/her academic and social/emotional projected growth. Thank you for trusting us with your children.
