Dear First Grade Parents,

We look forward to getting to know your children and partnering with you this year. As the new school year approaches, it would be helpful to us if you would share any information that you feel will help us get to know your child. For example, *How do you see your child as a person and as a learner? What does your child enjoy? What are your hopes for your child's first grade experience?* In late August or early September, after your child's class assignment has been shared with you, please email your thoughts to your child's teacher at our MKA email addresses (see below). - A large backpack (without wheels, please)
- An art smock (a large t-shirt works best) (All other art supplies for use in school will be provided.)
- A **complete** change of clothes, each piece **labeled** in a Ziploc bag. (The outdoor classroom presents fun opportunities that might result in getting wet.)
- Sneakers are **required** as part of the code of attire. Please also note that first graders wear MKA Primary School code of attire clothing daily. - A reusable water bottle to use while in school, clearly labeled on the side with your child's name
