Dear Families and Staff,

Good evening, just a brief update to start the weekend. This week we welcomed all students back on campus for a successful week of in-person learning. As the number of COVID cases and students who need to be quarantined continue to decline we anticipate a disruption-free remainder to the school year.

If you have not already done so, we encourage you to schedule your child for a COVID vaccine if they are 16 years of age or older. There is still time to schedule your child for the clinic being held at the Lord and Taylor Stamford Vaccination site. The first dose is tomorrow, Saturday, May 1, 2021 and second dose on Saturday, May 22, 2021, from 1:00-4:00 pm. The appointment time will be the same for both dates. [REGISTRATION LINK](#)

We also wanted to inform parents that fully vaccinated students are not subject to quarantine if they are determined to be a close contact of an individual who tested positive. If your child has received two doses of COVID vaccine, please submit a copy of their COVID vaccine card to the Darien High School Nurses at: [mlafeve@darienps.org](mailto:mlafeve@darienps.org). Please note: Students who have received a second dose of vaccine vaccinated by May 22 will be considered fully vaccinated for Prom and will not have to worry about contact tracing.
