Special Education Highlights- December 2017

The Community Crisis Intervention Team Training (CCIT) offered a five-day course in late November and early December, at the Cape Codder in Hyannis. CCIT offers crisis instruction to police departments on the Cape and provides Cape-wide community resources. This event was hosted by the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI). Various police departments across Cape Cod attended this program. The event demonstrated that "It Takes a Community" to tackle the multi-faceted problems of mental health. Representatives from several school districts (Barnstable, Mashpee, Monomoy, and Taunton) presented on how schools and school resource officers can work collaboratively in supporting students and their families.
