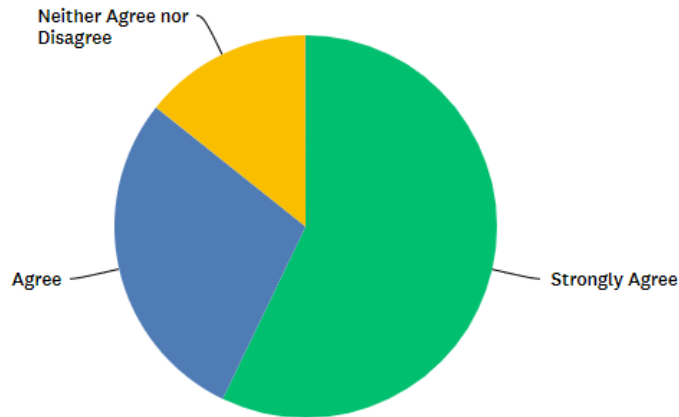


Board Survey to Address Monitoring Indicators for OE-8 “Communicating with the Board” November 25, 2020

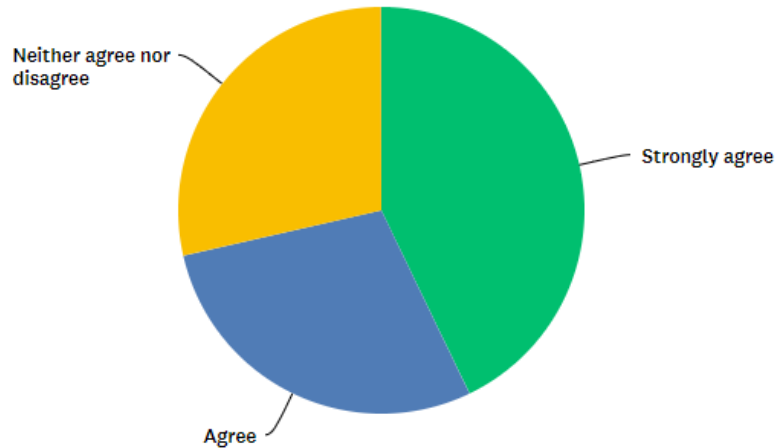

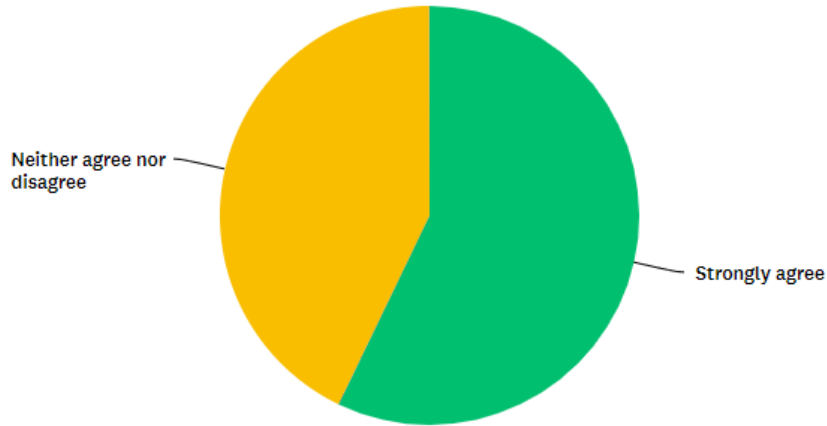

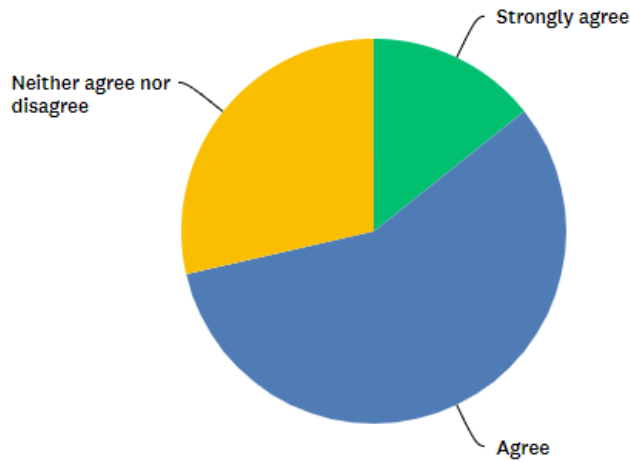
Comments (3)

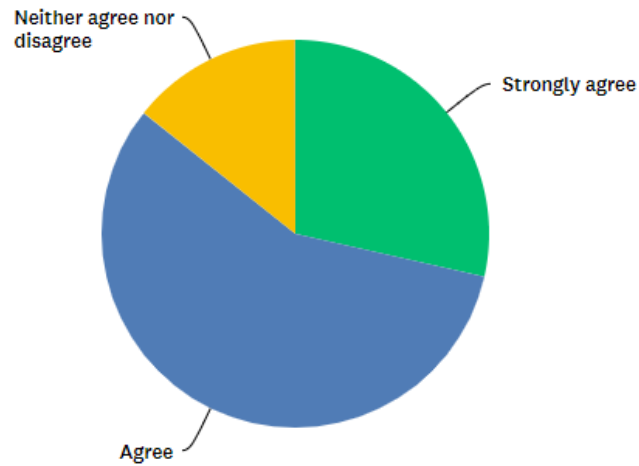
Comments (0)

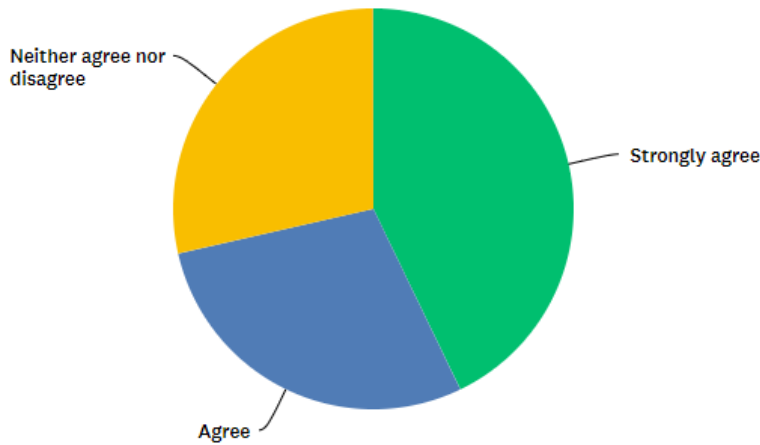
Comments (3)
