Student Handbooks

In order to inform students, parents and staff members of pertinent board policies, regulations, and school rules and procedures, the administration shall publish and annually revise student handbooks containing information about the school unit as a whole and the individual schools. The contents of student handbooks must conform with school board policies, administrative regulations, and state and federal laws and regulations. The school board or its designee shall conduct an annual review of the student handbooks. All handbooks and any revisions are to be reviewed by legal counsel and approved by the school board prior to publication.

Handbooks shall be distributed to all students the first week of each school year and to new students when they enroll.

Directory information may be released by the District to anyone who requests it unless I object in writing to the release of any or all of this information within ten school days of the time this handbook was issued to my child.
