RE: RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER THE MID-TERM BREAK: UPDATE 3

As part of its strategy to combat the continued spread of Covid-19, the Zambian government has decided to close schools "subject to inspections and review".

As a result, learning at Trident College will re-commence with online lessons on Tuesday 22 June until further notice.

Mirroring our approach at the start of the year, lessons will be delivered via Microsoft Teams. Online lesson timetables for each grade level are currently published and available from the Trident College website ([Teaching and Learning > Remote Session Timetables](#)).

To transition to online classes as smooth as possible, we ask that pupils use Monday 21 June to prepare. This process may entail resetting passwords, creating an at-home learning space conducive to effective learning, and ensuring they have all their books, stationary, and other materials prepared. If pupils have any questions regarding preparation for the classes, they are encouraged to contact their class teachers via email or MS Teams.

As per the start of the year, attendance in designated classes is compulsory. However, we are aware of network issues for some pupils. Should a pupil miss a lesson due to network availability, we ask that they contact their teachers to ensure work missed can be adequately covered.

Thank you once again for your flexibility. Our parent community is one of our most vital assets at Trident College, and we greatly appreciate your ongoing support.
