We are very excited to begin Oregon Battle of The Books (OBOB) with your students. This is a fun competition that will encourage students to read a wide range of genres and authors. It is also a great exercise in teamwork and camaraderie.

OBOB teams comprise of 3-5 team members at a time that battle to see who can remember the most facts about a book. Teams read 16 books that have been pre-chosen by a committee.

Parent support will be necessary in order for our students to successfully compete. *Each team will need a parent coach.* I will need 2 parent volunteers per grade to help during battles.
