

## CURRICULUM COVERAGE

### English and Destination Reader

In English and DR we will be reading a trio of books this term: *The Savage* by David Almond, *The Last Thing* by Shaun Tan and the *Watertower* by Gary Crew. All three books are full of mystery and suspense. These books also link well to aspects of PSHE, which is a big focus as the children get ready to move to year 6.

### Maths

Throughout the coming term we will be completing our work linked to position and direction. We will then be moving onto statistics and applying what we learn in a variety of ways.

### Science/ PSHE

Our science and PSHE link closely together this term as we continue with our work on life cycles. We will be moving on from plants and looking at animals including humans.

### Geography

This term we will be comparing the physical and human features of two countries (UK and Spain). We will be focussing on the following terminology: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes.

### PE

We will be continuing with our PE scheme focussing on the personal cog. The children will be giving and receiving feedback and creating targets to improve skill taught.

As Dynamic Ninjas we will have a positive attitude and be full of energy and new ideas.




As Inspirational Ninjas we will help our friends; approach work differently and take inspiration from others.





As Resilient Ninjas we will learn from our mistakes and bounce back from these.
