Happy summer break! The summer packet is available on King's website on June 18 and includes summer practice for all students entering Grade Three, such as a book list for read-aloud books and how to access the online platforms.

The *Summer Bridges* book is support for students to retain their academic skills over the summer months. It is designed for students to complete 1-2 pages each day. The book also includes fitness activities as well as fun outdoor extension activities. We ask that you support your child by reviewing your child's daily work. Make sure to remove the answer key at the back of the book to guide your child. Please return the Summer Bridges book in the fall to your child's Grade Three teacher.

Keeping a journal for sketching and writing down ideas, going on a hike or camping, visiting museums are wonderful ways to help your child continue to practice their writing skills.

Most of all, remember to PLAY- any activity can be play or not play, remember the secret sauce is *playfulness*. Be playful together and foster the skills that play can grow, such as developing the ability to see a situation and be curious about it, realize it can be enjoyable, and take agency over it.
