The KHS senior robotics team, 78889A, competed in the World Robotics Championship. The team became the 2021 VEX World Champions in Engineering Design!

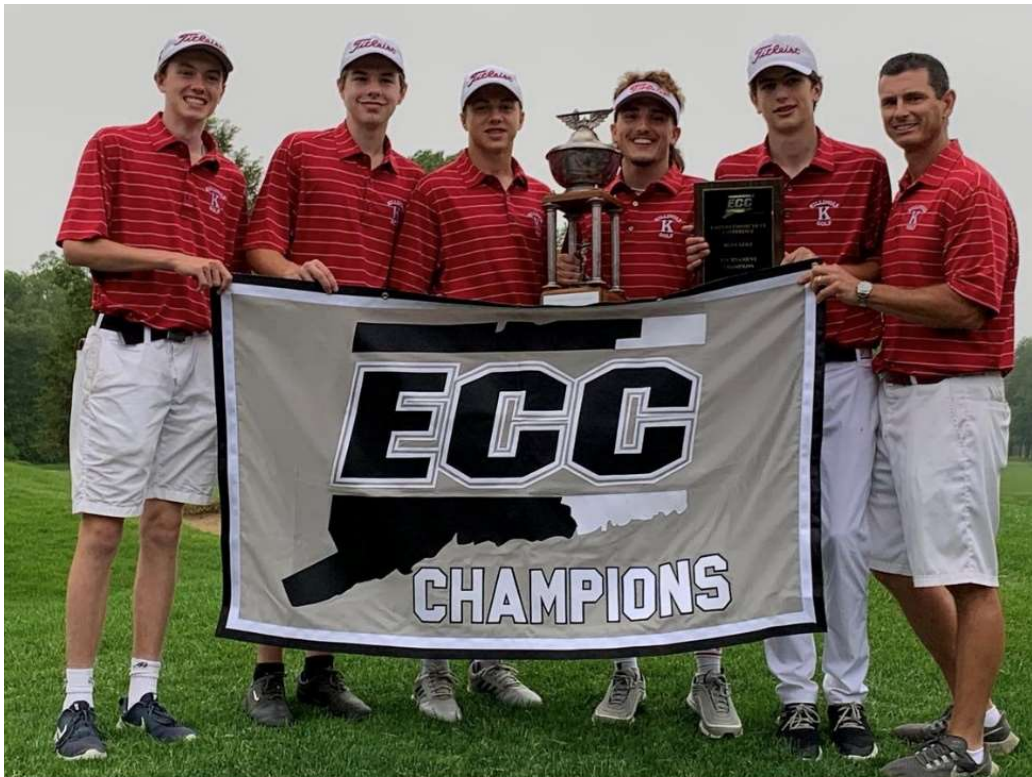
- **Sophie Griffin**, project manager and lead coder, lead the team through the engineering design process.
