## Audience Code of Conduct

Welcome to the St Dunstan's Festival. Keeping everyone safe is a priority for us and we ask that you help us by following this code of conduct.

### Do you have Symptoms?

If you have tested positive for covid-19 in the last 10 days or if you have any symptoms, please stay home. We may check your temperature on arrival at some events.

### Social Distancing

Whilst attending at any event please respect the social distancing markers. If you are moving around a venue or queuing please keep 2m between you and other guests, when seated we will be keeping an empty seat between your group and other guests.

### Wear a Mask

If you are attending an indoor event you will be required to wear a mask at all times unless you are seated and actively eating or drinking or have a valid exception.

### Track and Trace

When you arrive, please use the NHS app to scan the venue QR code to check into the event.

### Signs & Staff

No one wants to be the fun police so please respect our staff who are here to ensure everyone is kept safe. Abusive behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in you being asked to leave the Festival.

### Shouting & Cheering

Please show your appreciation for performer by applauding loudly. Unfortunately, you are not allowed to cheer or shout at events.

### Eating & Drinking

You are only allowed to eat and drink at events if you are seated. Please do not walk around with food and drink. There will be opportunities to buy refreshments at some events, but these must only be consumed once you are in your seat, this includes outdoor events.
