- III. Reports of Standing Committees for School Improvement
  - A. Trust Lands: Budget vs. Expenses
  - B. Reading Improvement – Acadience: 12% growth from BOY to EOY, saw 3 % growth from BOY to MOY, still working on achieving the goal.
    - Friday: gate will be open for an hour on Fridays.
    - Quarantining has been shortened, less interruptions now.
    - Changed up how Tier 3 Invention is being delivered to target exactly what kids need to improve.
    - Reading Inventory: Proficiency is at 53% for MOY –grew 8% from beginning of year.
    - \*\*Proposed change to goal for next year—Use Pathway Data to show growth when compared to their peers. 65% typical growth on Acadience Testing for end of year.
